## WHO WE ARE

We are SAPH, Saskatchewan Approved Private Homes, Inc. We represent approximately 400 home providers who care for our most vulnerable community members—close to 1100 residents of Approved Private Service Homes in Saskatchewan.



## WHAT WE DO

SAPH members provide a caring family environment and support for the residents who live in our homes. Some of our residents live with mental illnesses, cognitive disabilities, and some have limited mobility. All of our residents receive dedicated care, guidance, and protection as individuals whom we have welcomed into our families.

Our Approved Private Service Home (APSH) Providers bring experience, knowledge, and – most importantly – their sustained commitment to make homes for their residents in communities across Saskatchewan.

## PROFESSIONALISM, CARING, AND TRUST

Licensed through the provincial ministries of Health and Social Services, APSH Providers work closely with SAPH Inc. and these government departments to provide a safe and secure home for the residents in their care.

The care we provide begins with creating and maintaining a safe, secure environment for the residents we welcome into our homes. Beyond this, our Approved Private Service Home Providers work with SAPH Inc. to ensure residents receive services tailored to meet their individual needs.

An APSH Provider helps residents live successfully in the larger community to the extent their health permits. From offering help with life skills to ensuring medications are taken as prescribed, we provide a strong, secure place for residents to live with dignity, in the assurance that their privacy will be respected.

For their services, APSH Providers receive monthly payments. The amount is determined by the scope of services required to meet each resident's needs.

Once approved to deliver the service, Home Providers join SAPH Inc., expand their professional network, and draw upon the collective knowledge and experience of our membership.



## THE ROLE OF SAPH



Saskatchewan Approved Private Homes Inc. (SAPH) is a member-led organization for Saskatchewan's Approved Private Service Home Providers. A non-profit organization, SAPH has chapters in Prince Albert, North Battleford, Regina, Saskatoon, Moose Jaw, Swift Current and Yorkton.

We advise government agencies of the needs and requirements of approved homes, working with public sector representatives on legislation and policies affecting approved homes.

We also inform, educate, and counsel home caregivers and co-operate with the ministries that can help us work out solutions to any problems that may arise concerning the care of residents living in our approved homes.
